The Church of God 7th Day is actively engaged in missionary work. The church sponsored medical and dental teams to Chiapas, Mexico in 2006 and to Guatemala in 2007. "We go in the spirit of Matthew 28:19 - to help heal those with physical and spiritual needs, to spread the gospel, and baptize them into the brotherhood of Christ. ", says Dr. Eduardo Bermudez, who is the medical director for the mission and a local member of the church. Over the last two years, more than 3000 patients have received medical care and more importantly, many have given their lives to Christ.

The Medical-Dental Missions will be taking a team of 30 volunteers to **Nicaragua**. The local churches in the Sacramento area have raised several thousand dollars to support missionary efforts abroad. Since Hurricane Mitch in 1998, over 2 million people were left homeless. Eighty six percent of Nicaraguan children under 5 years of age live below poverty level.
